
## **Guideline for Installing the SS10, SS8 Warmers into Thick Countertops**



If you are installing a new round warmer in a location that had older units and a thick counter top, the cut out may be smaller than the recommended 11 1/8" (SS10) or 9" (SS8) diameter hole.

If that is the case, and you are having difficulty angling the unit into the opening, follow these steps to install your unit only if cutting the opening larger is not an option.

Step 1: Remove the (4) SCREWS that attach the ELEMENT CUP ASSEMBLY to the SIDE BRACKETS that are located on the side of the BOWL. Separate the BOWL from the ELEMENT ASSEMBLY & THERMOSTAT BULB.

<u>Step 2:</u> Insert the **BOWL** into the countertop opening. <u>DO NOT</u> apply caulk or attach the BOWL to the countertop at this time.

Step 3: From below, reattach the ELEMENT ASSEMBLY and THERMOSTAT BULB to the BOWL with the SCREWS from Step 1.
Rotate the BOWL if you need to access the holes in the SIDE BRACKETS.
Make sure THERMOSTAT BULB is properly seated in the BULB CLAMPS and is flush against the underside of the BOWL bottom.
Take extra care not to pinch the THERMOSTAT BULB. Tighten the Screws.

**Step 4:** Follow the remaining installation instructions that were provided with your unit for sealing and attaching your unit to the counter top.
